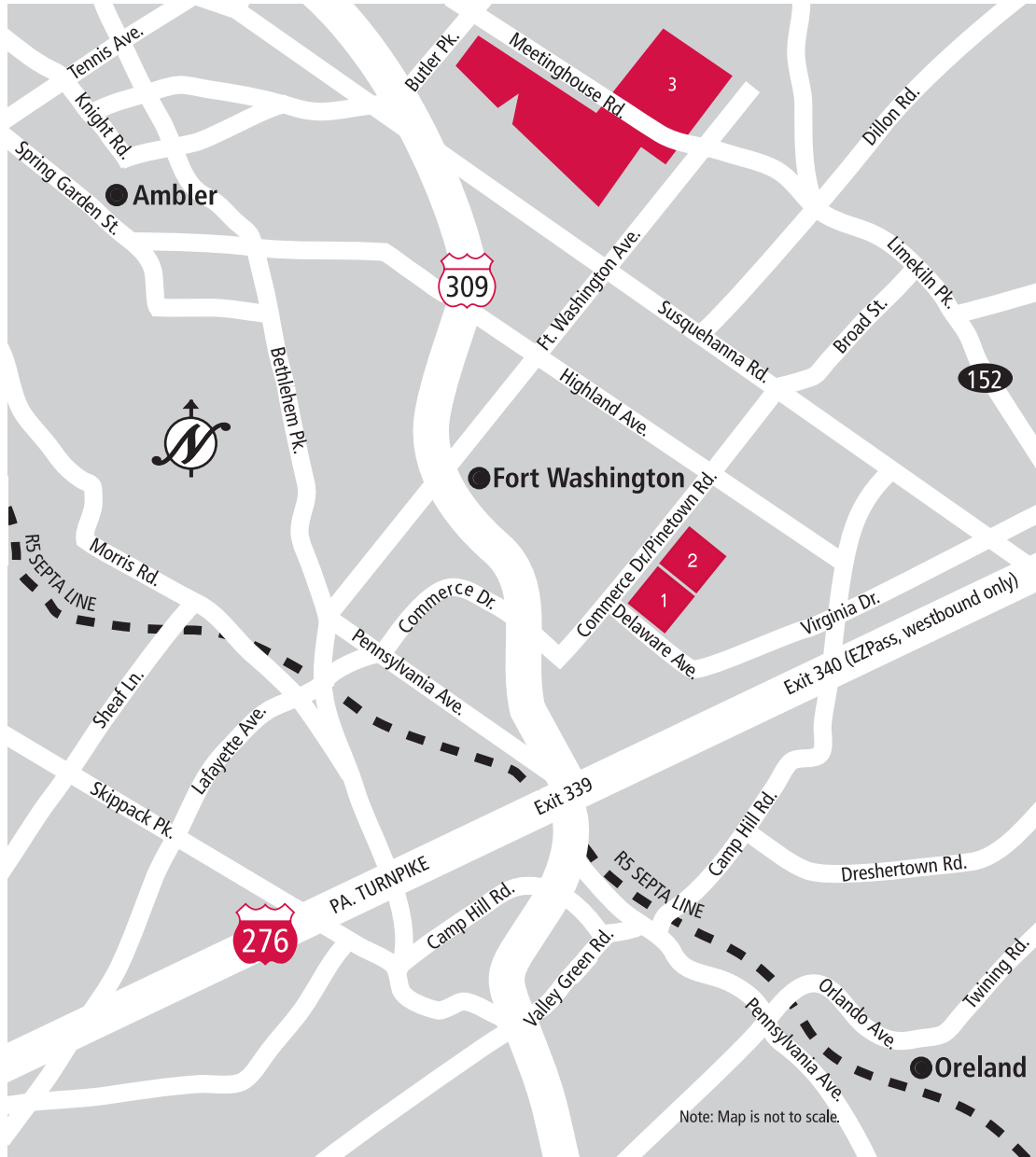

About the University

With more than 35,000 students and 17 schools and colleges, Temple University is a world-class comprehensive research and teaching university. Located midway between New York City and Washington, D.C., Temple offers a broad range of academic programs that attract students from every state in the United States and from more than 100 foreign nations.

The university has more than 3,200 full-time and part-time faculty members, many with national and international reputations. It is one of the top 100 institutions doing research for the federal government and has one of only three university-based national survey research facilities in the nation.

Temple offers bachelor's degrees in more than 125 fields, master's degrees in 113 and doctoral degrees in 52. The university also offers programs in five (5) first professional degree areas.

A member of the Pennsylvania Commonwealth System of Higher Education, Temple University is governed by a 36-member Board of Trustees. The university's primary sources of support are an annual appropriation from the commonwealth and student tuition. Ann Weaver Hart is the university's ninth president.

To Temple University Fort Washington

From points north (Montgomeryville):

Take Route 309 South. Exit at the Fort Washington/Pennsylvania Turnpike exit. Stay to the right for the Fort Washington exit and merge onto Pennsylvania Avenue. Make a right at the first light (Commerce Drive). Proceed 8/10 mile to the first traffic light at Delaware Avenue. Temple University Fort Washington is on the right, just past the intersection of Commerce Drive and Delaware Avenue. The parking entrance is the first right past the building.

From Broad Street and points south (Cheltenham):

Take Route 309 North. Exit at Fort Washington (just past the Pennsylvania Turnpike exit). Proceed straight ahead on the exit road, which becomes Pennsylvania Avenue. Make a right at the first light (Commerce Drive). Proceed 8/10 of a mile to the first traffic light at Delaware Avenue. Temple University Fort Washington is on the right, just past the intersection of Commerce Drive and Delaware Avenue. The parking entrance is the first right past the building.

From the Pennsylvania Turnpike:

Take Fort Washington Exit 339*. Proceed straight ahead on the exit road, which becomes Pennsylvania Avenue. Make a right at the first traffic light (Commerce Drive). Proceed 8/10 of a mile to the first traffic light at Delaware Avenue. Temple University Fort Washington is on the right, just past the intersection of Commerce Drive and Delaware Avenue. The parking entrance is the first right past the building.

*Exit 340 (Virginia Dr.) is ONLY available for EZPass ticket holders who are traveling west-bound. See map.

From Temple University Ambler:

Turn right from the Visitors Parking Lot (Lot #1) onto Meetinghouse Road. Proceed to Fort Washington Avenue (the first light) and make a right. Travel approximately 4/10 of a mile to first traffic light at Susquehanna Road. Turn left and go approximately 1/2 mile to the first traffic light at Pinetown Road. Turn right onto Pinetown Road (Pinetown changes into Commerce Drive) and travel about one mile to Temple University Fort Washington. Turn left into the parking lot.

Parking:

Parking is available in the lots adjacent to the 401 and 425 buildings.

Temple University Fort Washington

The Temple University Fort Washington Graduate and Professional Education Center offers graduate programs and non-credit courses for adult learners.
